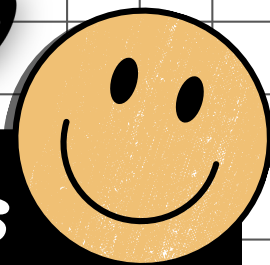

About the Class

Our study of Chemistry will include but is not limited to the following topics per the Alabama State Department of Education course of study standards: Matter and Its Interactions, Motion and Instability in Chemical Systems, and Energy. These topics are broken down into the following units: The Language of Chemistry, Atoms, The Periodic Table, States of Matter, Kinetic Molecular Theory of Gases, Intramolecular and Intermolecular Forces, Chemical Reactions, and Solutions. The skills required to succeed in this class include basic algebra skills, being present (physically and mentally), willingness to study and practice outside of class, collaboration, cooperation, and communication (specifically in asking for help). This is an Honors class, presented with the intent to prepare you for further courses in this content, such as AP or college chemistry.
