

Homeless, Migrant, Immigrant, Language Minority, and Foster Care Student Attendance Policy

It is the policy of Saraland City Schools to provide all students, including language minority students, migrant students, immigrant students, homeless students, and students in foster care with meaningful and appropriate educational programs allowing all students the same benefits and rights of participation regardless of race, color, disability, sex, religion, national origin, or age. The enrollment of homeless, migrant, immigrant, limited English proficient children and youth, and students in foster care shall not be denied or delayed due to any of the following barriers:

- Absence of school records or transcripts
- Absence of social security number
- Absence of birth certificate
- Absence of immunization or health records
- Absence of driver's license
- Absence of proof of residency
- Absence of transportation
