


Job Shadowing at Hargrove Engineering



BUILDING A FOUNDATION FOR STUDENT SUCCESS



Partnership Opportunities

- Clinical Experience an unpaid form of cooperative education for health science students. are required to complete 18 hours of clinical experience to qualify for the Certified Nursing Assistant credential.
- Cooperative Education combines CTE classroom instruction with paid employment that is directly related to the student's plan of study.
- Guest Speakers representatives from the company share information about the industry with classes or present during Career Day.
- Internships— places the student in a real workplace environment to develop and practice career-related knowledge and skills. Interns may be paid or unpaid.
- **Job Fairs** exposes students to part-time job opportunities such as temporary work for the summer or, if the employer prefers, students will be made aware of full-time position openings.
- **Job Shadowing** a student interviews a competent worker about his/her job and industry and "shadows" (follows) the worker to observe the performance of a variety of job tasks.
- Advisory Council-meets twice a year
