Expectations

Students are expected to be in their desks immediately after they walk into the room and begin the bellringer assignment. Students MUST have all materials needed. A positive attitude is expected so that maximum learning can take place. Students are expected to stay organized and keep up with all classwork and assignments in their binder.

Grades

Grades are determined by averaging Standards-Based Assessments (60%), Formative Activities (30%), and Speaking and Listening assignments (10%). Students are expected to read and study at home. A study guide will be given out each week. Students are also required to test on the books they read using Accelerated Reading. The AR goal is 10 points. Grades are based on the comprehension percentage and points accumulated. This will count as a test grade at the end of the quarter.

Absences and Make-Up Work

Students need to attend class every day. Absences are strongly discouraged. However, in the event of an absence, it is the student's responsibility to make up any missed assignments or tests.
