You must run for other office to be considered for representatives.

Eligibility to run and maintain all positions include:

- A minimum 2.5 grade point average (unweighted)
Mrs. Malone will verify this once your application has been submitted. Students do not need to turn in any form/documentation for their GPA.
- Upstanding representation for your class, at school, within the district, and at civic meetings
- Knowledge of parliamentary procedure - <https://www.britannica.com/topic/parliamentary-procedure>
- Must attend all meetings.
- Participation in ALL activities and events your class is spearheading.
- Behavior of academic integrity and respectable character on and off SHS campus, including on social media.
- **Must have served as a leader in an SHS club/organization over the past 3 years, with sponsor verification to run for President. This verification form should be turned into Mrs. Thames' no later Tuesday, April 23rd.**

Privileges for all positions:

- Will have a vote in all class decisions and may make motions to fellow class officers for consideration.

Additional information:

- ALL applications are to be completed/submitted online by accessing the link or QR code at top of this page.
- **NO LATE APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.**
 - ⇒ It is the student's responsibility to get recommendation forms/club leadership verification to their teachers in ample time.
- Teachers will place recommendation forms in Mrs. Thames' mailbox by Tuesday – April 23rd
 - ⇒ *Students do not turn in their recommendation forms.*
- **Candidates are not allowed to campaign on any type of social media, including but not limited to: Facebook, Instagram, Snap Chat, TikTok, etc.**
- **If a candidate violates the rule above and evidence is provided to Mrs. Munday or Mrs. Thames, the candidate will not be placed on the ballot.**
- **Voting will take place during homeroom, Wednesday, May 1st.**

Note: A student officer can have their position revoked at the discretion of the principal if duties are not being fulfilled or conduct portrayed by the student is unbecoming of a school representative. In the event a class officer or class representative receives an out of school suspension, the level of infraction will be considered, and possible dismissal of the student's leadership position may occur.
