shredded lettuce



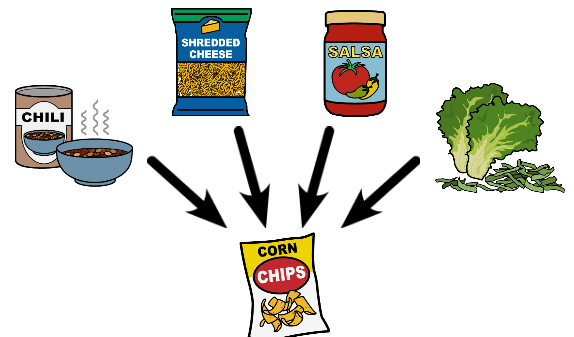
1 T sour cream  
(optional)



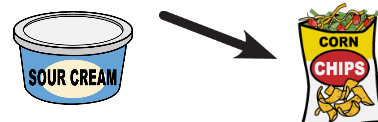
1. Crush chips slightly inside bag.  
Open bag.



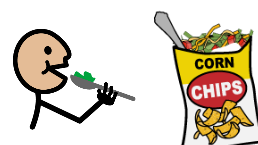
